- Blue letters are typed in conjunction with the AltGr key.
- “-” is the non-breaking hyphen (for example for “iman-is” in Kabyle)
- The deadkey gives the spirant equivalents of Tifinagh letters: e.g. X for t.
- The deadkey gives / for |, and // for ||, where required for older typefaces on older systems where the font does not do this automatically.
- Diacritics such as “.” are typed after the base letter.
- TIF is the Unicode Tifinagh Joiner character, for writing classical Tuareg.
- CAPS LOCK switches to a US (Latin) keyboard, for typing Internet URL's etc. Note: to obtain '\', type '\' then '\', and to obtain '|', type '\' then '|'.
