- Blue letters are typed in conjunction with the AltGr key.
- “-” is the non-breaking hyphen (e.g. for “iman-is” in Kabyle). “-” (+shift) is minus/hyphen.
- The “\_” deadkey gives the spirant equivalents of letters: e.g. ṭ for t.
- The ■ deadkey gives the Greek forms of letters: e.g. γ for γ, Σ for Σ.
- Diacritics such as “·” are typed before the base letter.
- Capital letters with diacritics are typed in most cases by typing the appropriate deadkey then shift+letter. Where this is not possible, shift+AltGr+letter can be used, or Caps Lock can be engaged then AltGr+letter typed.
- Install the keyboard driver under a language that has the correct smart quote behaviour (“” or «») and autocorrection (e.g. œ for oe). Alternatively, use the ■ and ■ deadkeys to get the letters you want. AltGr+space gives a no-break space.
